2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already filed a representation before the respondent no.3 (Annexure-P/3) but till date no order has been passed.

3. Accordingly, this writ application is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to file a fresh representation before the respondent no.3, within a period of two weeks, along with a copy of this order and other documents in support of his claim.



The respondent no.3 shall dispose of the representation of the petitioner within a period of four weeks’ from the date of receiving of such representation, by way of passing a speaking and reasoned order in accordance with law.

4. It is made clear that the respondent no.3 shall be held responsible non-compliance of this order within the stipulated period.
