The petitioner, who is a Panchayat teacher, has filed this writ petition challenging the order dated 28.12.2022, contained in Memo No. 06, issued by the Respondent No. 8/Panchayat Secretary-cum-teacher appointment unit under the Gram Panchayat Raj, Jhakhara under Block - Sikta, whereby, the petitioner's appointment as Panchayat teacher has been cancelled.

Since, the petitioner is a Panchayat teacher, in view of the Bihar State Teaching Institutions Teachers and Employees (Dispute Redressal and Appeal) Rules, 2020 and the decision rendered by this Court *in C.W.J.C. No. 10222 of 2022 (Rani Kumari Vs.
