2 09-09-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the
following relief:-

*"1.For issuance of writ in the nature of
Mandamus commanding the respondent
authorities to take serious action against the
private respondents who have again encroached
the public road (Gairmajura land) bearing Khata
No. 85, Khesra No. 5918, from which
encroachment was removed by the respondents in*
