learned APP for the State.

2. In this case, the petitioner is seeking regular bail in connection with Nawada P.S. Case No. 476 of 2024, registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a), 47 of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act, 2016.

3. As per allegation, 360 liters of illicit foreign liquor was recovered from a Bolero pick-up van, driven by the petitioner.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. He is a person of clean antecedent. He is merely the driver of the alleged vehicle and has no concern with the alleged



recovered liquor. The petitioner is under custody since 08.07.2024.

5. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances as well as the clean antecedent, let the petitioner above-named be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Court, Excise-2, Nawada in connection with Nawada P.S. Case No. 476 of 2024, subject to the following condition:-

(i) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.
