A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Gurua P.S. Case No. 76 of 2024 registered under Section 30(a)
of Bihar Excise Act.

3. As per prosecution case, 5 liters illicit liquor has been
recovered from the house of this petitioner.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case due to suspicion. Further
submission is that the alleged recovery has been made from the
joint family house of the petitioner. Nothing has been recovered
from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner
claims clean antecedent.



5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having considered the quantity and clean antecedent, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of eight weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Exclusive Special Excise Court No.-V, Gaya in connection with Gurua P.S. Case No. 76 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
