2 25-09-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Hajipur
P.S. Case No. 182/2024 registered for the offence punishable
under Sections 30(a)/32(3) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act.

3. 120 litres of illicit liquor has been recovered. The
petitioner is in custody since 22.06.2024. He claims to have
clean antecedent.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is ready to donate Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty-five
Thousand Only) in some charitable organization without
accepting his guilt.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case
and the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner, let the
petitioner above named be released on bail, on furnishing bail



bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Court No. II cum Additional District and Sessions Judge, Vaishali at Hajipur/ concerned court in connection with Hajipur P.S. Case No. 182/2024.

6. This is also subject to the condition that the petitioner shall deposit an amount of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty-five Thousand Only) in Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Nala Road, Patna and produce the receipt of the same before the Court below. The bail bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted after verifying the genuineness of the receipt produced by the petitioner.

7. The court below will also verify the antecedent of the petitioner. If the petitioner is found to be involved in any case, his bail bonds shall not be accepted.

8. The petitioner is directed to mark his attendance in Ganga Bridge police station on 1st Sunday and 3rd Sunday of every month. Failure to do so, will result in cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner.
