4 19-06-2024 Heard Ms. Shilpi Keshri, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Sanjeev Sinha, learned counsel appearing on behalf of Bihar State Religious Trust, Mr. Dhanjee Kumar Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Respondent Nos. 9 and 10 as well as learned AC to SC-19 for the State.
