2 03-10-2024 Heard learned counsels for the parties.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable under Sections 366A, 34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

3. As per the FIR, petitioners along with other co-accused
persons kidnapped the informant's sister.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that
petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence.
They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such
occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The
allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather



general and omnibus in nature. It is further submitted that the specific allegation is against co-accused Mister Ali and petitioners are his family members and they have concern with the alleged occurrence. It is further submitted that the victim is a major and she and co-accused Mister Ali have solemnized marriage which is apparent from Annexure-3 of the bail application. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Gopalganj Town P.S. Case No.385 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
