Permission granted with strict direction that if, in future, he shall repeat the same norm then, General Administrative Department, Bihar, Patna shall take action against him and cost of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) shall be imposed upon the petitioner which shall be payable to Patna High Court Legal Services Committee.

5. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
