APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with NTPC
P.S. Case No. 18 of 2024 instituted for the offences under
Sections 379 & 411 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, the police has recovered 15
pieces of Electrical HT Breaker components (silver quoted
copper) worth Rs. 1,12,500/- from the possession of the
petitioner which were kept in a sack.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence as alleged
against him and has falsely been implicated in the present case
due to petty village politics. He further submits that nothing



incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged occurrence. The petitioner has eight criminal antecedents and is languishing in judicial custody since 14.05.2024 without any rhymes or reason. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case.

5. On the other hand, learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Having heard rival contention of both the parties and considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case as also taking into account the period of custody of the petitioner, let the petitioner, abovenamed, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with NTPC P.S. Case No. 18 of 2024, subject to the following conditions;

(i) One of the bailor(s) shall be the own/close family members of the petitioner.

(ii) The petitioner shall cooperate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reasons, his bail bond shall be liable to be



cancelled by the court below.
