ORAL ORDER

2 01-10-2024 Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has stated that the petitioner has given a representation dated 09.08.2024 ventilating his grievance to the respondent authority and prayed this Hon'ble Court that the Respondent No. 4 may be directed to consider the said representation.
