2. The present application has been filed for
restoration of Cr. Misc. No. 19423 of 2020, which stood
dismissed for non-compliance of peremptory order dated
23.06.2023.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
inadvertently, the defect could not be removed within the
specific period and on 12.07.2023, an affidavited hard copy of
the brief had been filed before the registry.

4. In view of the averment made in the paragraph no.
9 of the restoration petition, the prayer for restoration is allowed
