ORAL ORDER

2 09-09-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1.This writ petition is being filed before this Hon’ble High Court on behalf of the aforesaid petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside form no.2 dated 06.06.2024 and Letter No. 832 dated 27.07.2024, as contained in memo no. 832, issued by the Circle Officer, Futauna, District- Madhubani, in Encroachment Case No. 06/2023-24, by which the petitioner hereinabove has been directed to vacate the aforesaid land otherwise legal process shall be undertaken against him and further date has been fixed for removal of encroachment as 20.08.2024, in connection with



the lands bearing Khata no. 829, Khesra no. 866, Jamabandi no. 723, Thana no. 23/4, admeasuring an area of 2 katha 17 dhur, falling within Mauza Majhaura, P.S.- Laukaha, District-Madhubani, without taking into account the order dated 04.12.2023 passed in CWJC No. 11653/2023.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a civil suit before the learned civil court of competent jurisdiction. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands disposed off.
