2 24-09-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

“1. (i) For direction to the Respondents concerned to initiate encroachment proceeding under the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956 against the respondents no. 9 to 10 for encroaching upon land of Government Middle School, Parbatta situated over Khesra No. 1374, Jamabandi No. 1300, in Village-Muradpur,



P.S. Parbatta, District- Khagaria.

(ii) For direction to the Circle Officer, Parbatta, District- Khagaria to initiate Encroachment Case against the private respondents no. 9 & 10 for encroaching upon the land of Government Middle School, Parbatta situated over Khesra No. 1374, Jamabandi No. 1300, in Village- Muradpur, P.S. Parbatta, District- Khagaria.

(iii) For direction to the respondents concerned to consider and dispose off the representation filed by the petitioner dated 29.06.2024 (Annexure-P/1 series)."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Parbatta, District-Khagaria, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
