ORAL ORDER

2 20-09-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in Saharsa Sadar
P.S. Case No. 72 of 2024, registered under Sections 341, 323,
326, 307, 379, 384, 386, 504, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that, on the
alleged date of occurrence the petitioner along with other co-
accused persons demanded ransom of Rs. 5,00,000/- and on
non-fulfillment of their demand they started assaulting the
informant and his friends by means of *lathi*, *danda*, sword, axe,
knife and pistol.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the



petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that there is no specific overt act alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has got one criminal antecedent in which he is on bail.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner. Learned APP for the State further submits that there is direct and specific allegation on the petitioner of assaulting Rupesh Mehta by means of sword several times causing injury on his head. The injury caused to Rupesh Mehta by the petitioner is grievous in nature. Hence, the petitioner does not deserve the privilege of anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, nature and gravity of offence, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. The prayer is rejected.
