2 24-09-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with N.D.P.S. Case No. 71/2024 arising out of Jogsar P.S Case No. 96/2024 dated 26.06.2024 registered for the offence punishable u/s 8, 20(b)(ii)(B), 25 and 29 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 2.600 grams. Ganja was recovered from the room of the co-accused Meera Devi.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The seized contraband is less than commercial quantity. The petitioner has two antecedents out of which one case is related to similar nature of offence and



he is on bail in both the cases as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 28.06.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Bhagalpur in connection with N.D.P.S. Case No. 71/2024 arising out of Jogsar P.S Case No. 96/2024, with the condition ;-

(i). The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
