ORAL ORDER

2 06-09-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Siwan
Town P.S. Case No. 344 of 2024 instituted for the offence under
Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Prosecution case in short is that while the
informant was going to Sadar Hospital, Siwan, he was accosted
with unknown miscreants, who on the point of pistol snatched
motorcycle of the informant, two mobile phones, purse
containing Rs. 8,000/-, Aadhaar card, PAN card, ATM card,
Watch and belt.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner is in custody since 05-07-2024. Petitioner



bears two criminal antecedents, as per disclosure made in paragraph No. 3 of the bail application.

5. It has been further submitted by the petitioner's counsel that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Petitioner is not named in the FIR. Name of the petitioner has transpired on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused, namely, Arjun Sah. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner goes on to submit that petitioner has no knowledge about the case and he is not concerned with the co-accused, namely, Arjun Sah.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and period of custody of the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Siwan Town P.S. Case No. 344 of 2024, subject to the following conditions:



(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.

(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
