2 18-09-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*“1.That this is an application for
issuance of appropriate writ /
order/direction commanding the
respondent authorities particularly the
Respondent No. 6, i.e. the Circle
Officer, Chiraiya, District-East
Champaran to initiate encroachment*



proceeding under the provisions contained in the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, in connection with public land bearing plot no. 3890 and 3891, Khata no. 18, situated at Mauza-Mirpur, Anchal Chiraiya, District-East Champaran, which is recorded in the right of record as Gairmazarua Malik Land.”
