*"1. a) For issuance of a writ in the
nature of Mandamus or any other
appropriate writ/writs, order(s),
direction(s) commanding and directing
the respondents to release the arrear
salary of the petitioner along with
consequential benefit accrued during*



the period 1993-1998 and further be pleased to direct the respondents to accommodate the petitioner at any suitable post as other 41 employees of the Corporation and even his juniors have duly accommodated by the respondents vide Memo No. 4726 dated 05.12.2019."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent authorities for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
