3 21-11-2024 Heard learned counsels for the parties.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 308, 379, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Allegedly, the petitioner and other co-accused persons assaulted the informant on her head due to which she became injured.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. It is further submitted that both the parties are agnates and there is an admitted land dispute between them.



The injury of the informant is also simple in nature. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case as well as considering the nature of injury, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Salaiya P.S. Case No.143 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
