seeking the following relief:-

"1. That this is an application for issuance of an appropriate writ/writs directing the respondents to pay the salary of the petitioners for the post of Panchayat Sewak in its regular scale of pay from the date of joining in the training for the post of Panchayat Sewak since 24.7.1998 till the date of posting 7.11.1998 in view of the Govt. decision issued vide memo no.1700 dated 15.4.2000 as well as direction issued by the Hon'ble High Court in the similar matter vide C.W.J.C. No. 3378 of 2002 and other similar cases and or



to grant any other relief or reliefs for which petitioner is legally entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case. "

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the respondent authorities for redressal of their aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
