2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Kewti P.S. Case No. 125 of 2023 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 341, 323, 324, 307, 379, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this application.

4. Permission is granted.

5. Accordingly, this application is dismissed as withdrawn.

6. However, if the petitioner surrenders before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today and prays for regular bail, the same shall be considered by the learned court below on the same day without being prejudiced



by this order considering the fact that there is no specific overt act against the petitioner and there is admitted land dispute between them. Learned counsel below is also directed to consider the Apex Court judgment in the case of **Satendra Kumar Antil Vs. Central Bureau of Investigation & Anr.** reported in (2022) 10 SCC 51 and in the case of **Arnesh Kumar Vs. State of Bihar** reported in (2014) 8 SCC 273.
