1/A May kindly direct the respondent authorities to maintain the status-quo in terms of selection of other candidates which final list had been prepared despite of lesser mark than that of petitioners."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the respondent authorities for redressal of their aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
