ORAL ORDER

2 19-03-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"1. That this application is being filed for issuance of appropriate writ / writs, order / orders, direction/directions with regard to quashing of the Order dated 28.07.2023, passed by Respondent District Magistrate, Saharsa in Anganwari Appeal No. 17 of 2020, whereby and whereunder the petitioner has been removed from the post of Anganwari Sevika and further directed to lodge FIR against her. The Petitioner further prays for a direction



to the Respondents to reinstate the petitioner on the post of Anganwari Sevika, for the Centre Code 302, Anganwari Centre-Kharra Musahari, situated at Ward No. 08, Village Kathdumar (Dah Kheda), Panchayat Kathdumar, Block Simari Bakhtiyarpur, District-Saharsa."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a suit before the Ld. Civil Court having competent jurisdiction, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
