seeking the following relief:-

"1) That this writ application is being filed for issuance of writ/writs in the nature of certiorari for quashing the orders dated 30/6/2021 passed in Aanganbari Appeal No. 5/17 passed by District Magistrate Gaya by which the aforesaid Appeal was dismissed and confirmed the order dated 28/4/17 passed by District programmer officer Gaya



in Aanganbari case No. 19/2013."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a civil suit before the learned civil court of competent jurisdiction.
