seeking the following relief:-

“1. That, this writ application is being filed for the setting aside the Anganwari Sevika selection Appeal No. 06/2019 against order dated 15.6.2022 which is passed by the District Programme Officer, West Champaran Bettiah, and/or pass such any order/orders, writ, direction for which the petitioner is found to be entitled to the fact and



circumstances of the case.”

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a suit before the Ld.
