2. This writ application has been filed for issuance of direction to the respondents to decide the Zamabandi Cancellation Appeal bearing Zamabandi Cancellation Appeal No. 26/2022 (Sri Raghunandan Prasad Vs the State of Bihar and Ors.), which was filed for assailing the order dated 28.04.2022 passed in Jamabandi cancellation No. 145/2021-22 , by the learned Additional Collector, Gaya .

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in Zamabandi Cancellation Appeal No. 26/2022 (Sri
