2 24-09-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

“1. That the present writ application is being filed for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus or any appropriate writ/ writs and order directing the respondent authorities to remove the illegal encroachment from the lands appertaining to Chak Khata No. 175, Chak plot no. 576, area 1.24 acres (nature-Pokhar-Pind), Plot no. 578 area 96 decimals (nature-Pokhar-



Pind), Plot No. 577 areas 10.87 acres (nature- Pokhar), plot no. 137 area 38 decimal, Plot No. 138 area 4 decimal (nature-public way), Plot No. 02 decimal, plot no. 531 area 80 decimal (nature- public way), Plot No. 559 area 94 decimal (Nala) and Chak Khata no. 174 plot no. 579 area 2.47 acres (public way), all of which are recorded as Anawad Sarwasadharan land, situated at Mauja Pasai, P.S. No. 770, Block-Rampur, which have been illegally occupied by the private respondents no. 6, 7 and his associates.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent authorities i.e. the Deputy Collector Land Reforms, District-Kaimur at Bhabua and the Circle Officer, Rampur, District-Kaimur at Bhabua, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands disposed off.
