the following reliefs:-

*"1. A. For direction to the respondents
to grant Notional benefit to the
petitioners as well as seniority to the
post of Panchayat Secretary w.e.f. the
date of vacancy i.e. 20.8.1998.*

*B. For direction to the respondents to
provide the benefit of old pension
scheme to the petitioners which was
withdrawn by the Govt. w.e.f.
01.9.2005."*

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel
for the petitioners seeks not to press the present



writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the respondent authorities for redressal of their aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The present writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
