2. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):-

“1. That by this writ application, the petitioner seeks indulgence of the this Hon'ble Court for issuance of an appropriate writ or writs, direction or directions commanding the respondent to consider and grant the 1st A.C.P. w.e.f. 03.07.2007 and 1st M.A.C.P. after completed 20 years of



service in the light of the ACP/MACP Rule, 2003/2009.”
