2 23-09-2024 Heard Learned Counsel for the petitioners and Learned Counsel for the State.

2. The present writ application has been filed for granting promotion to the petitioners on the post of clerk from peon considering the facts that they have completed 20 years of service and simi-



larly fourth grade employee have been promoted by the Health Department, Finance Department and General Administration Department, Bihar Patna.

3. Learned Counsel for the State raised preliminary objection and submits that the Government of Bihar through General Administration Department has framed a rule namely Bihar Government Servant Grievances Redressal Rules, 2019 to deal such type of situations and petitioners have liberty to exhaust the remedy before the Service Grievance Redressal Officer.

4. In the light of the submissions made, the present writ petition stands disposed off directing the petitioners to avail their remedy before the Service Grievances Redressal Officer of the department within 30 days from today and in the said rule, time frame has already been made. Therefore, Service Grievances Redressal Officer is hereby directed to decide this matter strictly according to the time frame specified in the said rule i.e. Bihar Government Servant Grievances Redressal Rules, 2019.
