2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a
case registered for the offence punishable under section 25(1-
b)a, 26, of the Arms Act.

3. As per FIR, the petitioner was apprehended on the
spot and on search two country made Rifles were recovered
from his house.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has
committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this
present case due to criminal antecedents. The petitioner has
no concern with the alleged recovery rather he has been made



accused in this case due to high handedness of the police officials. It is further submitted that the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 12.07.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer of Bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as judicial custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail **after framing of charge, if not framed**. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Barabar Pratayak (Vishnuganj O.P.) P.S. Case No. 82 of 2023 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate-Ist Class, Jehanabad.
