ORAL ORDER

2 05-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"i) For issuance of a writ in the nature of writ of certiorari or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, quashing the order dated 02.03.2022 passed in Case No. 07 Of 2021 (selection) by the District Program Officer Vaishali at Hajipur issued vide memo no.358 dt 02.03.2022 whereby and whereunder the appeal filed by the petitioner has been



dismissed on the ground that the objection has not filed by the petitioner within time.

ii) For the issuance of a writ in the nature of writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, commanding the respondent authorities to take necessary steps to appoint the petitioner on the post of Anganbadi sevika in ward no. 09, Center no.132 gram post-Chhourahi under Chhehrakala block District-Vaishali."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a civil suit before the learned civil court of competent jurisdiction. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
