"1. To issue an appropriate writ / writs order/orders, direction/directions in the nature of mandamus to institute criminal case against the private respondent through investigation agency i.e. Enforcement Department, Prihar Branch and Vigilance Department or holding an independent enquiry by any enquiry agency against the respondent no.6, who has taken illegal gratification to the tune of about Rs.20 crore."
