ORAL ORDER

2 24-09-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned APP for the State.

2. In this case, the petitioner is seeking regular bail
in connection with Rupauli P.S. Case No. 82 of 2024, registered
for the offences punishable under Sections 25(1-b)a, 26/35 of
the Arms Act.

3. As per allegation, on a secret informant, the
police party reached the place of occurrence. Seeing the police
party, the petitioner along with co-accused Md. Sarfaraz started
fleeing away but they were apprehended. On search, one
country-made pistol was recovered under the pillow of accused
persons.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has
submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in this case. He has submitted further that nothing
has been recovered from his conscious possession and he is
under custody since 31.05.2024.



5. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above-named be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Purnea in connection with Rupauli P.S. Case No. 82 of 2024, subject to the following condition:-

(i) The petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.

(ii) **Before accepting the bail bond, the learned court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and if it is found that he is involved in any other case except the case which has been mentioned in paragraph 3 of the bail petition, his bail bond shall not be accepted. The criminal antecedent must be verified from all the police stations of the district.**
