4 28-03-2024 Heard Mr. Md. Waliur Rahman along with Mr. Nishant Kumar Sinha, learned counsels appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Subhash Pd. Singh, learned GA 3 for the State.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner informs that the petitioner has filed a representation dated 26.09.2019 before the Executive Officer, Nagar Parishad, Warsaliganj, District, Nawada and the same is pending without any reason.

3. Considering the aforesaid submission made on



behalf of the petitioner and taking into consideration that the representation of the petitioner is pending since 26.09.2019, the Executive Officer, Nagar Parishad concerned is directed to take steps to dispose of the representation dated 26.09.2019, filed on behalf of the petitioner, if the same has not already been disposed of, by passing an appropriate order in accordance with law after giving due opportunity of hearing to all the affected parties including the petitioner, well within a period of three weeks from today.
