ORAL ORDER

2 25-09-2024 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well
as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner is seeking regular bail in connection
with Janta Bazar P.S. Case No. 137 of 2024 for the offences
punishable under Sections 317(4), 317(5) r/w 3(5) of the
Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. The allegation against the petitioner is that one
stolen *scooty* was recovered from possession of the petitioner.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
this case. He has further submitted that as a matter of fact,
during course of returning from local market after purchasing
domestic articles, during course of vehicle checking, he was
made victim of the circumstances and the police maliciously



implicated him with the seized *scooty*. He has also submitted that the petitioner is a person of clean antecedent and is under custody since 21.07.2024

5. On the other hand, the learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances especially the clean antecedent of the petitioner, let the petitioner above-named be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand rupees) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate-Ist Saran at Chapra in connection with Janta Bazar P.S. Case No. 137 of 2024, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make himself available as and when required by the court.
