reliefs:-

“1(i). For issuance of a direction to the respondents to remove the illegal construction, made by the Respondent no. 8, by encroaching the government road/land, which is used by the several common people of the locality including the petitioner.

(ii). For issuance of the direction to the respondents to remove the encroachment made



over the Public land, which has been encroached by Respondent No. 8, by constructing a building without any approval of the competent authority, which would be clear from the map of the land given by the Amin, after measurement of the land.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Sadar Bettiah, Distict-West Champaran, for redressal of her aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
