2      21-09-2024      The present writ has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That by way of this writ application, the petitioner prays for issuance of writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ/ writs/ direction/ directions/order/ orders commanding the respondents especially the Circle Officer, Runisaidpur to execute and implement the final order, passed in Encroachment Case No. 09/2023-24 and thereby remove the encroachment from the Bihar Government's Land (Gair-Majarua Land),



appertaining to Khata No.-5194, Khesra No. 602, 603, situated at Thana No.-72, village and Mouza- Manik Chowk, Anchal and Police Station- Runni-Saidpur, District-Sitamarhi, which has been encroached by the private Respondents No. 6 and 7.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the District Magistrate, Sitamarhi, for redressal of her aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
