3 01-03-2024 The present petition has been filed for restoration of a writ petition bearing C.W.J.C. No. 5167 of 2020, which has stood dismissed for non-prosecution, by an order dated 11.10.2022.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on account of inadvertence the list could not be marked resulting in the counsel for the petitioner being not able to appear before this
