2      30-04-2024                      The limited prayer made by the petitioner in the present writ petition is to direct the District Arms Magistrate, Nawada/ District Magistrate, Nawada to dispose off the application filed by the petitioner in the month of December, 2020, for grant of arms licence.

2.              The learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case the aforesaid application is still pending consideration, the same shall definitely be disposed off, within a stipulated time frame, as is directed by this Court.
