2 17-10-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323,
354(B), 379, 376, 385, 511 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the informant
alleged that when she went for attending call of nature, then the
petitioner caught hold of the informant and tried to drag her. It is
further alleged the petitioner also tore the sari and blouse of the
informant with ill intention.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not
specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He submits that
the petitioner opened a nursery about 400 meters east from his



house and, near nursery in a vacant land, several persons used it for unsanitary activity. When the petitioner protested the same, then the informant lodged false case against the petitioner. He further submits that the medical report has not supported the prosecution case. Petitioner has one criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposes prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Bakhtiyarpur P.S. Case No. 39 of 2024, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
