ORAL ORDER

3 17-12-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with N.D.P.S. Case No. 97 of 2024 arising out of Sadar P.S. Case No. 271 of 2024 dated 27.04.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/s 8(c) 21(b) of the N.D.P.S., Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 10.60 gram of smack kept in 31 *puria* were recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner has no concern with the said recovery.



The said contraband is less than the commercial quantity. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has clean antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 28.04.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Muzaffarpur, in connection with N.D.P.S. Case No. 97 of 2024 arising out of Sadar P.S. Case No. 271 of 2024, with a condition/s:-

(i). The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
