At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners requests disposal of the writ petition with direction to the Additional Collector, Rohtas at Sasaram (Respondent No. 3) to dispose of the representation which was filed by the petitioners on 31.08.2023 (Annexure-4) on the recommendation of Circle Officer, Dehri, Rohtas, but no action has been taken till date.
