2 30-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

"1 (i) To issue a writ of Mandamus or any other writ or writs, direction or direction commanding upon the respondents to remove the encroachment made by respondent No. 7 & 8 over Public Road Land at Khesra No. 1158, situated in Village- Bhabrue, P.S & Anchal-Madhuban,



District- East Champaran over which the Respondent No. 7 & 8 have erected hut by which obstruction is caused to the petitioner as well as other villagers passing through that road land."

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Madhuban, District-East Champaran at Motihari, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
