Considering the limited relief as sought for on behalf of the petitioner, the petitioner, if so advised, may file a detailed representation giving all the particulars in their own respect before the the Chairman, District Selection Committee-Cum-District Mangistrate, Aurangabad for consideration of their grievance and the the Chairman, District Selection Committee-Cum-District Mangistrate, Aurangabad is directed to consider the grievance of the petitioner expeditiously in accordance with law.

5. With the aforesaid direction/observation, the writ petition stands disposed of.
