"(I) For issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order/orders, or direction/directions commanding the Respondent



authorities to provide protection/security to the petitioners by way of deployment of police force in order to enable him to construct the boundary wall over his ancestral land for which the petitioner is ready to bear the cost to be incurred for the same;"

After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the District Magistrate, Patna and the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patna for redressal of their aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
