2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Sikta P.S. Case No. 70 of 2024 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 414, 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, co-accused Anurag yadav was apprehended with motorcycle in question and he disclosed that the said motorcycle is stolen one and he had purchased the motorcycle in question from Sonu Kumar (petitioner).

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence as alleged in the FIR and he has falsely been implicated in this case. Petitioner bears criminal antecedent of one case in which he is already on bail and it is not similar to the present case. He further submits that except



disclosure of co-accused,Anurag Yadav, there is nothing on record to demonstrate the complicity of petitioner with the alleged occurrence. It is further submitted that allegation against the petitioner is well planned as occurrence took place on 01.06.2024 and FIR was lodged on 02.06.2024 and there is no plausible explanation given for delay in lodging the FIR.

5. The learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, argument advanced on behalf of both sides, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M. 1<sup>st</sup> Class, West Champaran, Bettiah in connection with Sikta P.S. Case No. 70 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

7. The application stands allowed.
