2 22-10-2024 Heard the parties.

2. The petitioners apprehends their arrest in connection with Salaiya P.S. Case No.104 of 2023, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 363, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the FIR, the petitioners along with one other person gave Rs.2500/- to the co-accused Dinesh Kumar @ Chedi and others to kidnap the minor son of the informant.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. There is no specific overt act against the petitioners. They have



been made accused on the basis of statement of apprehended co-accused. Petitioner no.1 has one criminal antecedent and petitioner no.2 has no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail by submitting that the petitioners are also involved in the present case.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case as well as considering the nature of offence, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The prayer for grant of anticipatory bail on their behalf is hereby rejected.

7. Accordingly, this application is dismissed.

8. However, if the petitioners surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today and seek for regular bail, the learned Court below shall pass the order on the same day in accordance with law.
