seeking the following relief:-

"That this application is being filed with a prayer for issuance of an appropriate writ/ writs for quashing the order dated 21.06.2023 passed by the respondent no.4 namely the Divisional Commissioner, Munger Division,



Munger by which he has dismissed the appeal preferred by the petitioner affirming the order dated 01.12.2022 contained in Memo No. 1577 passed by District Programme Officer, Begusarai by which the appeal preferred by the petitioner was rejected."

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a civil suit before the learned civil court of competent jurisdiction.
